Research where your power is coming from - wind, water, coal, or solar - and talk to your power provider to determine if a greater % could be coming from renewable resources. Encourage power providers to switch to green power and, if possible and/or economically viable, switch to a company offering power from renewable resources. Alake recycling part of your daily routine. Recycle all packaging and consumer goods that you can. Sim to purchase items with minimal and recyclable packaging. For items with large amounts of packaging, ask retailers if they can recycle or re-use it. For electronics, facilities exist that dispose of electronics in an environmentally responsible manner.

Rather than discarding or recycling clothing and household goods, give them a chance at a second life. Gently used clothing can be donated to charity or exchanged with friends and family. Old T-shirts can be repurposed into rags for cleaning. Thousehold goods can be donated to charity or sold at a garage sale.

Through repurposing, the amount of waste being sent to landfill sites is reduced, there is no need to use energy for recycling, and others can benefit from your used items, hen gardening, select plants that are well suited to your climate and require minimal watering and attention. Better yet, plant a tree, and it will provide shade and soak up carbon from the atmosphere.
