18pt / 23 – Mixed Weights

Humans have been able to conquer and **find answers** to most of the world's mysteries, but death remains unconquered. **The speculations over ghosts** have been raving for a long time, but **concrete evidence of life after death has not been found**. According to believers, there are many different types of ghosts while scientists argue that ghosts and spirits have been born **out of the fear** of humans.

14pt / 20 – Mixed Weights

A haunted house, *spook house* or *ghost house* in ghostlore is a place that is thought to be associated by the haunting spirit **with some strong emotion of the past**, such as *remorse, fear, or the terror of a violent death*. The traditional **visual** manifestations of haunting include **ghostly apparitions**, the *displacement of objects*, or the *appearance of strange lights*; **auditory** signs include *disembodied laughter and screams, footsteps, ringing bells*, and *the spontaneous emanation of sounds from musical instruments* (sometimes not even present in the house).

11pt / 17 – Mixed Weights

MOST HAUNTED PLACES IN THE WORLD. Ghost hunters everywhere are always **trying to catch a glimpse of a spirit wandering a haunted hallway**, hear mysterious voices in an empty room, or even feel a chill as they're investigating a dark corridor. **Luckily enough**, there are numerous reportedly haunted places that are open for public tours or even overnight stays. **No matter where you are in the world, there's probably a haunted house, hotel, or old historical site that's waiting for you to visit**. Ghosts, strange sounds and lights, and even have been reported at these famous places in *the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Romania, and as far as Australia and China*.

8pt / 12 – Mixed Weights

TRADITIONAL APPARITIONS are a specific type of ghosts that interacts with human beings. *This can be for good or for evil*. These ghosts are said to **hide objects, frighten people, throw objects or plea for help**. These ghosts are said to be present because of **unfinished work**. This can be due to their death in untoward circumstances, and they generally **seek human help** to resolve the issue and **progress into a different realm**. These spirits are said to be **"intelligent"** yet haunting, as they appear to be aware of the people around them and their surroundings.

6pt / 10 – Mixed Weights

A **ghost** is the soul or spirit of a dead person or animal that can appear to the living. In *ghostlore*, descriptions of ghosts vary widely **from an invisible presence to translucent or barely visible wispy shapes, to realistic, lifelike forms**. The deliberate attempt to contact the spirit of a deceased person is known as **necromancy**, or in spiritism as a **séance**. *Other terms associated with it are apparition, haunt, phantom, poltergeist, shade, specter or spectre, spirit, spook, wraith, demon, and ghoul*. The belief in the existence of an afterlife, as well as manifestations of the spirits of the dead, is widespread around the world and part of many cultures. According to a 2009 study by the Pew Research Center, **18% of Americans say they have seen a ghost**. The overwhelming consensus of science is that **there is no proof that ghosts exist**. Their existence is impossible to falsify, and ghost hunting has been classified as **pseudoscience**. Despite centuries of investigation, **there is no scientific evidence that any location is inhabited by spirits of the dead**.

Peter Underwood (1923 - 2014) was described as “*an indefatigable ghost hunter.*”

30pt / 36

The “Borley Report” concluded that Price had fraudulently faked haunted phenomena in the Rectory.

20pt / 26

Ghost hunting, or “paranormal investigation”, is the process of investigating locations that are reported to be haunted by ghosts. Typically, a ghost-hunting team will attempt to collect evidence supporting the existence of paranormal activity.

40pt / 48

These spirits are afflicted with an insatiable hunger for a particular substance or object.

30pt / 36

Pretas are believed to have been false, corrupted, compulsive, deceitful, jealous or greedy people in a previous life.

20pt / 26 - Alternate 'a' (SS01)

There are many festivals around Asia that commemorate the importance of hungry ghosts or pretas. Many rituals involve burning symbolized material possessions or fake money, thus linking the concept of the preta with the deceased's materialism in their lifetime.

White Lady

40pt / 48 - Alternate 'k' (SS02)

The best-known White Lady of the Czech Republic is the ghost of Perchta of Rožmberk.

30pt / 36

In Japanese folklore, the *yūrei* and *onryō* are frequently depicted as women with long black hair and white dresses.

20pt / 26

White Lady legends are found in many countries around the world. Common to many of these legends is an accidental death, murder, or suicide, and the theme of loss, betrayal by a husband or fiancé, and unrequited love.

Hitchhiker

Many similar stories have been reported for centuries across the world...

30pt / 36

The vanishing hitchhiker is an urban legend in which people travelling by vehicle meet with a hitchhiker who turns out to be *a ghost*.

20pt / 26 - Circled Numbers (SS03)

- ① Stories where the hitchhiker gives an address through which the motorist learns he has just given a lift to a ghost.
- ② Stories where the hitchhiker is an old woman who prophesies disaster revealing her to be deceased.
- ③ Stories where the hitchhiker is later identified as a local divinity.

Beetlejuice

30pt / 36

Who is everyone's favorite friendly ghost? Casper has been (not) scaring up audiences since his days as a comic strip. This beloved ghost went on adventures trying to spread as much kindness as he could in a world that thinks all ghosts are bad.
